#### Welcome back to the new school year!

It is lovely to see the children back at school after the summer break, looking very smart in their uniforms! A few start of term notices and reminders:

- Staffing Congratulations to Mr and Mrs Logan and to Mrs Hutchinson (Miss Welch) on their marriages this summer. We welcome back Mrs Willcock back into Reception class; we also welcome Mrs Summerill and Mrs Nattrass to the school team. We congratulate Mrs Cope on her application for a new post in County Durham; we will be sad to see her go at the end of this term, but wish her well for her new job. We will soon be recruiting a new teacher for Year 5.
- Mrs Harris is sending home copies of data collection sheets this week please check the details we hold, particularly emergency contact information – let us know if there are any changes needed and please ensure we have up to date contact telephone numbers.
- Mrs Harris has new stock for anyone wishing to purchase uniform.
- Your child will be bringing home a class letter please ensure you make a note of PE days it is best to send PE kit in at the start of each week, so children have this on hand, but they must have a change of clothes on PE days. Please remember jewellery must be removed for health and safety reasons.
- Your support with punctuality and attendance is vital. We operate a first day absence procedure. If your child is absent for any reason, please contact school. You can leave a message of send in a text. Children whose attendance last year was below 90% are classed as having persistent absenteeism medical evidence (appointment cards, etc) will be needed for any illness. Please contact Mrs Harris if you have any concerns.
- Inhalers were sent home at the end of term. If you have not already done so, please send in a new inhaler if your child needs one. We will ensure your child has access to this in class.
- Holiday requests a reminder that we are not authorised to grant leave of absence in term time except
  for exceptional circumstances, and the Local Authority will now intervene if your child accrues seven
  days or more of unauthorised absence in a term (this includes ALL unauthorised absence holidays
  and any unauthorised sessions, including late after registration).
- 2019-2020 School Holidays A reminder that this year (2019-2020) some of our professional development days are blocked together so families can benefit from a slightly extended closure and use this as an opportunity to book holidays at a cheaper rate. The planned dates when school will be closed for PD days in 2019-2020 are:
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019
  - 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2020 these three days follow the May half term week (thus giving a slightly longer block)
  - Monday 20<sup>th</sup> July 2020
- Any child wishing to join the **school bank** and start saving each week, please see Mrs Harris in September we collect and bank monies every week and it is a wonderful way for children to save up.
- A reminder that we ask that parents do not drive into school to drop off or pick up, including for breakfast club – especially into the staff car parking area - unless by prior agreement with the headteacher. The speed limit for those with permission is 5mph.
- Breakfast club begins at 8am.
