Horizontal lines run left and right across the page.	Vertical lines run up and down the page.	Perpendicular lines meet each other at a right angle.
This is a right angle.	Two right angles make a half turn. Three right angles make three quarters of a turn and four complete a turn.	Parallel lines always stay the same distance from each other and never meet.
