Communication and Language

- Experience of vocab through stories, rhymes, games and discussion - people who help us, people we love, people in our community, winter, the queen.
- Developing listening and attention through paired games, length of stories and bingo games.
- Talk around safety in the house and when outside such as, safety near water, wearing seatbelts, crossing the road, holding adults hand, wearing helmets on bikes, when in the kitchen using sharp knife with adults around, careful with things that are hot.

<u>Literacy</u>

- A wide range of topic themed stories in our reading garden including fiction and non-fiction related around people who help us, winter, our family and the queen.
- Interactive resources available each week for children to have the opportunity to retell focus stories.
- Themed paper for writing and drawing opportunities with template pictures to cut and colour.
- Thank you letters and cards for people who help and love us.
- Large scale mark making opportunities in tuff spot with various tools for drawing shapes and lines.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Who are people who help us in our community, who looks after us, what they do to make our lives better.
- Discussion around safety in the house and when outside or on holiday.
- Discussion around people who help us with different things such as, doctor, dentist, firemen etc.
- Talk and appreciation for people we love, people who are the closest to us, who looks after us and why.
- Role play opportunities, developing friendships through co-operative play in theme - people who help us and people we love.

Physical Development

- Movement games responding to actions for certain people e.g. climbing ladders for firefighter's picture.
- Props provided to support imaginative play to encourage physical movements e.g. tubes for hose pipes, blocks set up for emergency vehicles.
- Outdoor spay bottles to put out 'chalk/foam fire'.
- Various tools to support sand pit building site wet sand and sponge blocks.
- Opportunities to support cooking skills using various tools to roll, chop and scoop with discussion around healthy living (relate to doctors and dentist).
- Fine motor experiences through malleable activities rescuing people using tweezers, play dough opps.
- Gross motor obstacle course games using large blocks, cones, rope, bean bags and balls.

People

Mathematics

- Number rhymes and songs resources available in reading garden such as, 5 little frogs and new 5 brave firefighters.
- Provide a range of 2D shapes in dough to support malleable play.
- Emergency vehicle and winter themed puzzles involving shape and size.
- Exploring colour and pattern through peg boards etc.
- Threading available using smaller beads to manipulate.
- Sorting and matching clothes etc. people who help us.

Understanding the World

- Visits from people in role for talks and sharing of jobs.
- Learning around people in our area who help us and loved ones.
- Controlling of cars and other vehicles, pressing buttons to control and direct.
- Taking on role of people who help us

 using knowledge learned and
 cameras to capture photos of
 children dressed up.
- Use software on IWB to make marks and press buttons to achieve a result.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Develop junk modelling skills to build emergency vehicles and hats.
- Large scale construction for building emergency vehicles including boxes in role play to support imaginative play.
- Learning of new songs and rhymes around theme.
- Observational paintings around people using colours to match emergency service.
- Experimenting with musical instruments to create warning music.
