Dear Parents,

Welcome to the beginning of Reception year! ③ Your children have settled beautifully into their classrooms and we are so excited to get going with lots of learning and fun this term. Our topics this term are Food and Feasts and Pets. Our key texts include 'I will not ever never eat a tomato', 'Biscuit Bear', 'The Little Red Hen', 'Lulu Gets a Cat' and 'Oh No George'.

Your child will be exploring and learning all about; food, friendship, our home life and family, how we have changed since we were a baby, celebrations, animals, using and applying numbers to 3, matching, sorting, comparing amounts and size, patterns and shapes, change in seasons (summer to autumn), harvest in church and in school and exploring music through rhyme.



<u>Helping at Home</u>

As we are building up your child's independence in school it would be great if you could help out with this at home too. Some things we are working on is putting on our shoes and socks ourselves, putting on and fastening our coats, helping with buttons on

trousers or cardis and using the toilet independently. This will support them to be able to get dressed themselves by the time January comes around ready for P.E.
