Communication reminder:

We only share rewards on class DoJo but all other communication is via text messages/Arbor/school email or by seeing your class teacher/headteacher on the school yard/class door.

Communication is key so please get in touch at the earliest instance if you need to speak with staff. We are here to help.

Medical reminder:

We are only able to provide **Calpol** in an emergency situation. If you know in advance that your child might need Calpol then parent/carers need to provide this for school to administer.
