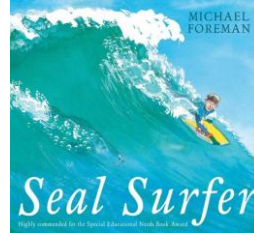

**Key Knowledge (Formal Elements) :**

**Shape:** How to use basic shapes to form more complex shapes and patterns. **Pattern:** Patterns can be irregular and change in ways you wouldn't expect. **Pattern:** The starting point for a repeating pattern is called a motif, and a motif can be arranged in different ways to make varied patterns. **Texture:** How to use texture more purposely to achieve a specific effect

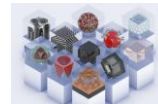

**Focus :** Properties of materials

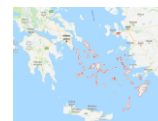
**Key knowledge :**

- Compare and group together everyday materials on the basis of their properties,
- Know that some materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution
- Use knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating
- Learn how to give reasons, based on evidence from comparative and fair tests, for the particular uses of everyday materials, including metals, wood and plastic.
